President *Greg Simmonds*

Before turning professional, Gregory Simmonds was his high school's (Sherwood High School, Olney, Maryland) first ever All-American athlete — the second is US National stand-out Oguchi Onyewu. He also still holds the record for goals scored at his alma mater, Howard University. Simmonds began his professional soccer career with the Hershey Wildcats where he scored 35 goals, had 16 assists and was named USL-1 Rookie of the Year in 1999 and Team MVP in 2000. Simmonds also played for D.C. United in the CONCACAF Champions Cup in 1999.

Simmonds also boasts international experience, having played with the Jamaican National Team youth and senior teams (Reggae Boyz) in 1999. Signed by the Miami Fusion in 2001, he tallied 4 goals and 2 assists in league and Open Cup matches. After the Fusion folded in 2001, he signed with Rochester Rhinos in 2002 where he led the team with 9 goals and 6 assists. In 2003, he played in 27 games with the Richmond Kickers. Simmonds played for USL First Division team Charleston Battery for the 2004 and 2005 seasons and was the team's leading scorer both years with 18 goals and 9 assists. In 2006 joined Virginia Beach Mariners where he was team MVP after leading the team with 9 goals and 5 assist and being named to the league's ALL STAR TEAM.

Simmonds finished his professional career with 75 goals and 37 assists, last playing for the Puerto Rico Islanders.

Simmonds retired from professional soccer shortly after he founded the Soccer and Futsal programs at U-TURN Sports Performance Academy where he served as Director for over 3 years. Simmonds then became the Co-Founder and President of Own Touch Soccer., as well as Co-Founder and President of FutsalRVA. Simmonds is a US National Pro A License Coach. FutsalRVA has produced four US Youth National team players from and currently has five US Youth Futsal National Championship titles.





Executive DirectorJoe Farrell

Joe Farrell, the co-founder and co-owner of FutsalRVA, is a former youth professional player in his home town of Glasgow, and played collegiately in the US. In Scotland, Joe was one of the youngest licensed coaches with the Scottish National Soccer Association, as well as a respected community director for the Glasgow Sports Council. Joe has coached in the US for 19 years. For the last 15 years, Joe served as both Director of Coaching and Technical Director, where he helped develop the structure and delivery of many youth grassroots and elite programs in Richmond. Joe has also worked with the Olympic Development program and was the head coach of the Chesterfield NPSL team who achieved amazing success including winning a bid to the 2016 US Open Cup.

Joe is a highly talented Director with energy and enthusiasm that impacts and inspires all who work with him. Joe has a wealth of coaching experience and his positive, infectious approach has made him highly respected and successful throughout the Richmond community. Joe has built a reputation of being a true player's coach and Director, relating easily to the needs of players and parents both on and off the field. Throughout his coaching career, Joe has had many successes in boys, girls and adult programs. Joe has led local Richmond travel teams to victory in the VYSA State Cup Championships and is the first Coach in Richmond to lead a team to a Region 1 Championship. Joe has also taken FutsalRVA teams to the USYF National Championship finals.

Joe's qualifications include USSF A license, NSCAA Advanced National, USSF National Youth License, Director of Coaching Diploma, Higher National Diploma in Sports coaching and a degree in sports science.

In 2007, Joe with his partner Greg Simmonds, had the vision to create the first USYF Futsal league in Richmond. Over the past several years, Joe has worked hard behind the scenes strategically creating one of the largest and most successful youth futsal leagues, tournaments and academies in the United States.

Joe is also the USYF State ID director, State and Regional tournament director as well as a USYF Academy program director with his partner Greg Simmonds..

Our goal is to make sure that FutsalRVA provides the highest level of training, coaching and communication. FutsalRVA Juniors is geared towards U5-U8 year-old players with all levels of experience including beginners, recreational and developmental players. FutsalRVA Juniors provides players a full futsal training session followed by games in 3 v 3 and 4 v 4 formats. Children are placed in classes with similarly skilled players in order to maximize their development.

Players between the ages of 5 and 8 are in the "golden age" of development. The appropriate training program can have a tremendous impact on the future success of a player and his or her passion for the game. The early mastery of technical skills is one of the most important elements in the development of youth players.

FutsalRVA juniors are also encouraged to develop their mental, physical, and social abilities through creative games and other activities. Players learn age-appropriate individual skills, teamwork, and most importantly they have a lot of FUN!

Summer and Winter Seasonal Development *Player Birth Year: 2014-2016*

The FutsalRVA Summer and Winter Programs will provide futsal-specific training for players between 8-12 years old. The programs are designed to be a comprehensive futsal experience that combines training and game play in a practice setting for 6 weeks in the summer and winter. Some of our main objectives are to:

- Provide high quality developmentally appropriate training to improve soccer/futsal skills
- Provide an opportunity to play a competitive game after training where players can implement and apply the skills they learned (with the guidance of a FutsalRVA coach).
- Provide 1 quality training per week for 6 weeks
- Provide Participation in and end of season Festival/Game night with FutsalRVA academy teams with qualified FutsalRVA coaches
- Provide quality training based on the FutsalRVA curriculum
- Continuously evaluate the progress of each player for opportunities within the FutsalRVA Academy.
- Have no more than 16 players in a training group and no more than 9 players on a team during games.

BENEFITS OF FUTSAL AND THE FUTSALRVA SUMMER DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM:

Futsal naturally helps develop skills required for soccer: balance, motor ability, agility and coordination, ball mastery, accurate and quick passing and receiving, perception, insight, and awareness. Children learn skills through repetition, especially when they practice in tight areas while under pressure.

The appropriate training program can have a tremendous impact on the future success of a player and his or her passion for the game. The early mastery of technical skills is one of the most important elements in the development of youth players.

Developmental Academy *Player Birth Year: 2013-2014*

FutsalRVA Developmental Academy (FDA) is a program offered to all players (boys and girls) ages U8-U10 looking to participate in a year-round futsal academy with experienced and qualified coaches. Players are placed in groups with similarly skilled players in order to maximize their development. This program will be either boys, girls or coed and will serve as a pathway to the FutsalRVA Academy.

The FDA will heavily focus on player development through improving technical ability, game awareness and tactical decision making. FDA Academy training will provide challenging technical drills, games, and exercises in order to increase confidence and enhance critical foot skills. Training will also build upon the fundamentals of dribbling, decisions under pressure, and passing in a fast-paced format. The program is designed to build the foundation for teaching tactical components that will improve the player's understanding of the game. All FDA players will have the opportunity to compete in the FutsalRVA winter league (included in fees) and also have the optional opportunity to play additional tournaments and special events.

FutsalRVA Developmental Academy is open for ANY/ALL players & teams, regardless of their club, level and/or town/city affiliation. FutsalRVA Developmental Academy training is designed to complement, not compete with, a player's club soccer training.

Uniforms



Please read and abide by the following guidelines:

- Bring all uniform equipment to every game including all uniform shirts, shorts, socks, Futsal shoes, warm-up shirts, warm-up suits and tape.
- Players should be dressed alike during team warm-ups before games.
- Uniform socks will be pulled up whenever you have them on. Shin guards must always be covered by socks.
- Arrive at games looking professional (i.e. Team Warm-Up Suit, Team Warm-Up Shirt).
- Have your FutsalRVA equipment bag with you at all practices and games. Put bags carefully in a row on the sidelines at all games. Keep bags in a proper team location at practice.
- Wear proper training jerseys for all training sessions.
- Bring your water bottle with you to all practices and games. At games, place your water bottle behind your bag when not in use. To prevent passing on illnesses to teammates, you should not share water bottles!!!
- Leave your rings, watches, necklaces, bracelets, earrings, other jewelry and hairpins (except for rubber bands or other elastic bands) at home or in your equipment bags.
